DESERT SONATA (Francelle Edwards 2010) 38", E. \$50.00. An amazingly vigorous and floriferous iris. It will produce ten to fifteen bloom stalks on a second year clump, making a splendid show in the garden. Then it will continue blooming for a long time. The stalks are well branched and produce seven to nine blossoms with a delicate, pink-gold iridescence best appreciated close up, as on a show bench. Its performance contradicts the delicate appearance however. It has excellent substance, able to stay fresh in heat and wind. Sdlg. 76-25 Barbara My Love X Pink Champagne.



COOL JAZZ (Lesley Painter 2010) 38" M-L. \$45.00. White standards have a slightly creamy base. Falls are wisteria violet lightening or becoming white around the white beards which are touched yellow in the throat. Reddish-brown lines appear at the shoulder edges. Lightly laced petal edges adds elegance to the large and gently ruffled flower. Tall stalks produce 7-8 buds. Produces large rhizomes. Seedling L98-25 (Jazzed Up x Spring Rhapsody). Received an HC award in 2004.



REGAL VIEW (B. Nicodemus 2010) M 38", \$45.00 Standards icy white; style arms icy white, light blue-lavender midribs and upper edges. Falls light blue-lavender, paler borders; Beards yellow tipped light blue-lavender at ends; ruffled. 2 branches & spur, 7 buds. Seedling #G46-4, Sea Power x Sierra Grande.



FUZZY WUZZY ROCKET (Kathie and Leonard Jedlicka '10), EM 38", \$50.00 The standards are coral-pink; style arms are coral with touches of orange and lavender. The flaring falls are royal red-purple with a coral-pink border. It's a consistent spaceager with 1/2" fuzzy lavender-pink horns at the end of plump tangerine beards. The great stalks are 38" tall and there are 7 buds on good branching. Healthy floriferous plants produce showy ruffled and laced flowers. [Norma Jean x Too Sweet] X Coral Pincushion.



INNER CHILD (Otterness 2010) 34", L. \$50.00. This child of Planned Treasure x Whispering has hot orange-red beards, light ruffling, and excellent increase. Palest orchid standards are infused smoky violet, with deeper smoky violet bases and midribs. Smoky violet falls are overlaid silvery orchid with deep smoky violet borders Sdlg. B-38 (RHS 87C).
